Since arriving in Britain, New Zealand baritone Kieran Rayner has been engaged by Garsington Opera, Longborough Festival Opera, English Touring Opera, Scottish Opera, VOPERA, and British Youth Opera, among others. A graduate of the Royal College of Music Opera School, he was a Young Artist with Garsington (winning the Sandbach Prize), Independent Opera, Verbier Festival, Samling Arts, Britten Pears Foundation, and the Internationale Meistersinger Akademie, and is generously supported by the Kiri Te Kanawa Foundation. He was a Wigmore Hall International Song Competition semifinalist and Royal Over Seas League prizewinner.
